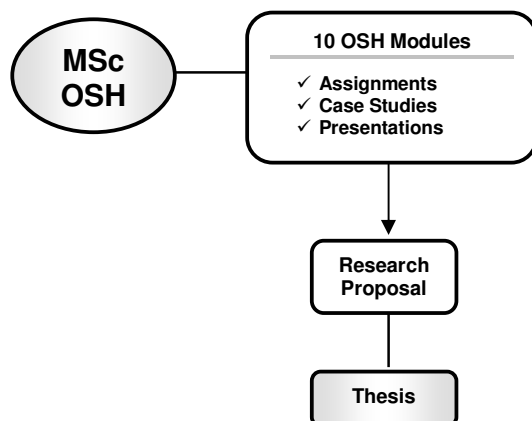

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Preston University is licensed pursuant to Wyoming Statute, rules and regulations. Presently, the state of Wyoming has only three universities with on-campus programs offering under-graduate and graduate degrees. They are the University of Wyoming in Laramie, Senior University in Evanston, and Preston University in Cheyenne. The University of Wyoming is a state university while Preston and Senior Universities are private. Preston University is licensed in Wyoming as a degree-granting institution.

The state of Wyoming, in an effort to protect the integrity of private degree-granting institutions, passed legislation in 1996 that set forth both qualitative and quantitative guidelines for licensure. As a private university, Preston is required to fully comply with our Wyoming statutes (specifically, Enrolled Act No. 45, Session, signed by the Governor on March 20, 1996) which sets forth the following. The act relates to private school licensing; mandating licensing of private schools and agents as specified; requiring on-site inspection and visitation of post secondary education facilities by the state department of education; imposing license application requirements, reporting requirements and modifying license provisions for post secondary education institutions; modifying license fees as specified; providing for license suspension and revocation; providing specific practices; modifying bonding provisions; granting rulemaking authority and imposing additional duties; and providing for an effective date. The Department of Education monitors private universities to insure compliance with our laws, rules and regulations.

Assessment Methods

The assessment is by means of a work-based assignment/term paper for each unit which is to be submitted within 2 months on completion of studying a module. The work will be based upon the module just completed and students will be given guidelines as to the criteria that must be satisfied. The work must be of a high standard and students will be expected to exhibit an ability to critically evaluate data or situations, and where appropriate to present recommendations, with supporting arguments. All assignments/term papers are internally marked and reviewed by the external examiners.
